PLEASE LEAVE A VOICEMAIL IF YOU GET NO ANSWER WHEN YOU CALL

There are times when you call for a tee time or information at The Legends Golf Club and you get directed to our voice mail. This happens because our staff at the front counter is likely checking in golfers or they are on the other line servicing another caller.

The Legends has four incoming lines and many times calls happen at the same time. We feel it is better customer service to have you go to our voice mail system rather than be put on hold for a lengthy time. **If you call during normal business hours, we promise you will get a return call from our staff within an hour of your phone call - or you will receive a free sleeve of golf balls!** But, if you do not leave a voice mail, we cannot call you back!

REMINDER ABOUT BOOKING HOT DEALS ON GOLF NOW

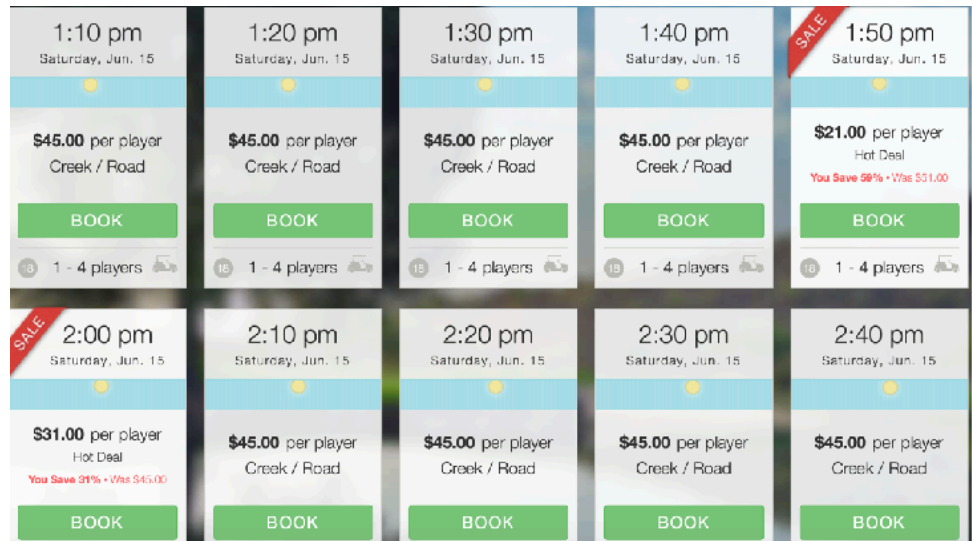
Over the past 18 months we have talked about this issue numerous times.

Golf Now has proprietary control over two tee times each day. They have a red ribbon on the tee time window that says 'SALE' and the language 'HOT DEAL' is in the window.

You will be required to pay for these hot deals and that fee goes to Golf

Now - not The Legends. **Our golf course cannot give you a credit or issue refunds. When you book these times, there is a language that tells you the hot deals are non-refundable.**

DO NOT BOOK THESE TEE TIMES UNLESS YOU ARE PREPARED TO PAY FOR THE TIME SLOT.



Golf Tips and 'Ready Golf'

Course Management - Number 2 Creek

I know, I know....there are some of you that would rather NOT play the Creek Nine. Well, I'm here to help you love it! To do that, I'm going to give you some tips on how to manage the course and shoot better scores.

Number 2 Creek is a challenging Par 3 from any tee box - it is easy to want to take dead aim at the pin and fall victim to a left to right wind and end up in the water. Many of my regular students have learned to take the correct aim by picking out a target to the left side of the green, however, they will choose the incorrect club. For this hole your ideal landing spot - to stay out of trouble and escape with no worse than a bogey - is short left of the green. To do this, you need to club down - if you have 150 yards to the pin, take your 130 yard club and aim to the left side of the fairway/landing area. This will keep you out of trouble and give you a good look at pin on your second shot. If the pin is middle or back you can hit a nice little bump and run shot to the middle of the green, 1 or 2 putt for par or bogey and move on to the next hole with confidence.

Ready Golf

We want everyone to enjoy their time at The Legends and a big part of that is being able to play in a timely manner. While we don't expect you to rush through your shots, there are small things that you can do during the course of a round that can ensure a good pace of play. Our pace of play guidelines are 2 hours and 5 minutes per nine, which is very achievable regardless of skill level!

One of the easiest ways to play in a timely manner is to simply be ready when it is your turn. Sounds pretty basic, right? But often times it is not the case. While your playing partner is hitting his/her shot, you can be finding your yardage, getting your glove on and deciding what club to use so that once they hit their shot, you are ready to hit yours! This simple act can shave a considerable amount of time off your round and not leave you feeling like you are rushed!

Player Responsibilities
