Rules of Play

Covid-19 Precautions and Local Rules:

1. Registration: All registration will be done outside of the main clubhouse near the putting green. Players need to register 30 minutes prior to their tee time, pay their entry fee and pick up a rules sheet and an opponent's scorecard.
2. The flag stick remains in the hole at all time. Do not touch or remove.
3. All Bunkers are played as Ground Under Repair. Relief: 1 Club Length no nearer the hole.
4. The starter will give you your opponent's scorecard on the tee – do not trade cards, keep your score on the bottom. At the end of your round, check scores at the scorer's table in front of a tournament official, do not trade cards to sign.
5. Social Distance: Please stay 6 feet apart at all times.

Player Expectations:

1. All players are expected to fix ball marks on the green and repair divots in the fairway.
2. All players are expected to exhibit respect towards their opponents, tournament officials, spectators and the golf course.
3. The Legends GC (The Committee) will set standards of behavior, such as a 1 stroke penalty for club throwing or disqualification for intentionally damaging the golf course or any other serious example of misconduct.

Spectator Expectations:

1. All spectators MUST stay on the cart path or AT LEAST 50 yards away from players at all times.
2. Please stay out of the field of play at all times.
3. No advice or conversation with players is allowed.
4. Spectators are allowed to help look for lost golf balls, but should not help with rulings.

Other Rules of Play:

1. Rule 21.2b will apply. **The maximum score on any hole is double par.** (i.e. 6 on a Par 3, 8 on a Par 4, 10 on a Par 5). Players must pick up when they reach this score and circle it on the scorecard.
2. **Pace of Play** – Groups should play in no more than 15 minutes/hole and maintain their position within 1 hole of the group ahead of them. Groups may be warned and any players who fall outside the expected pace will be times. Any player who exceeds 40 seconds on any shot will be warned. The Committee may penalize the entire group – Penalty for 1st Offense is 1 Stroke, 2nd Offense is another 1 stroke penalty, 3rd Offense is disqualification.

1. **Out-of-bounds** at The Legends GC is defined as follows: *Creek Nine*: White Stakes on 1, 4 and 9. *Middle Nine*: White Stakes on 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 and 9. Fence on 8. *Road Nine*: White Stakes on 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 18. Fence on 14 and 15. Road behind 15 and right of 16- marked by white stakes.
2. **Red Penalty Areas** are as follows: *Creek Nine*: 1 lake and creek (left), 2 lake and ditch (right), 3 wetland and ditch (right), 4 lake (right), 5 creek (left), 6 creek (left), 7 creek (left), 8 creek (left), 9 creek and lake (left). In addition all long grass areas on 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 are Red Penalty Areas defined by the cut of rough. *Middle Nine*: 3 lake (left), 4 creek (right) and lake (in front of green) and ditch (right of green), 5 creek (right), 6 creek (right), 7 lake and 9 lake (left). In addition all long grass areas on 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 are Red Penalty Areas defined by the cut of rough. *Road Nine*: 10 lake (right), 11 lake (left), 12 lake (right), 14 lake (behind green), 15 lakes (right) and 18 (right). In addition all long grass areas on 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 are Red Penalty Areas defined by the cut of rough.
3. **Yellow Penalty Areas** are as follows: *Creek Nine*- NONE. *Middle Nine*: 3 creek (in front of tee), 6 ditch (between 2nd and 3rd landing area). *Road Nine*: 15 creek (in front of green).
4. The planter and flower bed behind Middle 2 green is a No Play Zone and mandatory relief with no penalty is granted under Rule 16.1f.
5. **Optional Drop Area**: On 4 Middle and 15 Road

Rules of Play Par 3 Division

Rules and Expectations:

1. **Registration:** All registration will be done outside of the main clubhouse. Players need to register 30 minutes prior to their tee time, pay their entry fee and pick up a rules sheet. The starter will hand out official scorecards.
2. The flag stick remains in the hole at all time. Do not touch or remove.
3. All Bunkers are played as Ground Under Repair. Relief: 1 Club Length no nearer the hole.
4. If a player hits a ball in tall grass or water on the Par 3 Course, they may take 2 club length relief from the point where they think the ball went in and add 1 stroke to their score. i.e. if you hit the ball in tall grass on your tee shot, go to that spot, take relief and you will be hitting your third shot.
5. Spectators need to stay on the cart path at all times – but they can help players look for golf balls.
6. **Social Distance:** Please stay 6 feet apart at all times.
7. At the end of play, return to the scorer's table to check your scores and turn in cards (near the main clubhouse).
