9-10 Year Olds will Shotgun out at 5:45 on the Par 3 Course.
8U Players will Shotgun out at 6:00 on the Par 3 Course.

Match Information:

- Upon arrival - go to the Dye Building and pick up a warm-up bucket of balls for the player.
 - Confirm your child's tee time, course and/or hole assignment. Grab a scorecard and a pencil for scoring.
 - Have them go up to the driving range and set their bag by a cone behind the designated age group sign. Have them leave their bag at the cone and only take the clubs they need.

- Coach Lowell and Coach Alexandria will be running the 11-13 yr old age division.
- Coach Annabelle and Coach Crystal will be directing the 10 and under age group.
- **Spectator Carts:** Spectator Carts are in limited supply and must be purchased at the main golf shop. You will be asked to sign a waiver form. The cost is \$10 for the Par 3 and \$14 for the Creek 9.

Other Information:

- 11-13 Year Olds: All players are expected to walk and manage their own equipment. No caddies and we ask that parents stay on the cart path and only help look for golf balls.
- 9-10 Year Olds: All players are expected to walk and manage their equipment – no caddies. However, I would like 1 or 2 designated parents to act as scorekeepers for the group and help look for golf balls, make sure the players are moving along at a quick pace.
- 8U players: A parent or guardian does need to caddy for their player to help keep score, manage equipment, help them choose which golf ball to select, etc.

Everyone needs to return their scorecards to the Dye Building and make sure their team score gets posted on the scoreboard.
